Purpose of consultancy:	Background: ADRA Japan collaborates with ADRA Nepal, for "Health Reform Project" funded by MoFA Japan in Bardiya district of Nepal. One of the mair goals of the project is to 'Improve the quality service provision leading to increased availability of nutrition care as well as WASH services which contributes to sustainable and equitable access to nutrition care and WASH facilities through collaboration among government and local communities. Furthermore, the project has designed a major intervention to increase the accessibility to safe drinking water in targeted communities (marginalized Dalit, indigenous, minority, and disabled) The overall objective of the assignment is to provide technical support or design, estimation and construction of 'Overhead Tank and Water Distribution System' along with supervision of all tasks related to construction
